

COVID-19 Update / MWRA Continuation of Service


MWRA's critical mission is to provide safe and secure drinking water and wastewater services to our customers. During the pandemic, we have continued to do so while at the same time protecting our employees, contractors, and neighbors

- On March 22, MWRA limited staffing
- On June 24 we returned to full O&M staffing at Deer Island
- Masks mandatory with social distancing
- Following Governor Baker's recommendation, all staff that can work from home are working from home



Wastewater Testing - COVID-19 indicator with Biobot

- Since June, MWRA has contracted with Biobot Analytics to test for COVID in the wastewater at Deer Island
- This data is provided to Public Health officials ad an additional tool to help track the virus

Update on Deer Island Fishing Pier construction

- The Mass Department of Fish and Game Fishing Pier is nearly complete
- The pier could be open soon
- Official ribbon cutting planned for spring 2021







Update on Deer Island Fishing Pier construction (cont.)

- 9 Space Handicap accessible lot constructed, coarse paving complete
- Opening pending completion/testing of Security Enhancements
 - Lighting (complete)
 - Cameras (complete)
 - e911 Call Boxes (pending testing)






- MWRA continues to work with first responders to improve response actions

Tafts Avenue - Shirley Street Intersection Redesign

- MWRA has designed an alteration to the Tafts Avenue-Shirley Street Intersection
- Construction has been bid, pending award
- Construction planned for spring 2021

- On-Going Projects
 - Gravity Thickener Rehabilitation
 - Chemical Tank Relining Project
- Future Projects
 - Clarifier Rehabilitation, Phase II
 - New Solar Canopy Project being recommended for approval




